COVIDSafe Conditions Of Entry

Conditions of Entry to Redhead Surf Life Saving Club

Listed below are the Conditions of Entry into Redhead Surf Life Saving Club premises:

- Social distancing must be adhered to, including 4 square metres per person and 1.5 metres between individuals.
- Those attending are encouraged to have the COVIDSafe app installed on their mobile phones.
- Any people who are feeling unwell should not enter the club's premises.
- All people entering and leaving the club are required to sign in using the provided Entry Register; which:
 - Will be stored for 28 days,
 - Will be handed over to NSW Health should it be requested, and
 - Will not be used for any other purpose.
- No groups of larger than 10 are allowed.
- Cleaning must occur as detailed in Annex B of the RSLSC COVIDSafe Action Plan. This will vary depending on the activity being conducted.
- A person must be nominated and clearly visible who is responsible for ensuring that social distancing is being adhered to. This person will have the authority to close the premises if this does not occur.

For those using the Auditorium for other than a function, the hygiene requirements are:

- All surfaces that are touched are to be wiped down regularly;
- All door handles, hand rails, tables and chairs that are used are to be disinfected before and after use; and
- Any toilets that are used are to be disinfected before and after use.

It is the responsibility of the user of the facility to ensure that all hygiene requirements are adhered to.
